Lieutenant McManus, District Commander for East Naples Patrol District (District 3), 1 2 reported on recent activity. There have been 912 traffic stops, with 162 citations issued 3 and 741 written warnings. This year, there have been 170 traffic crashes, with 107 4 being minor parking lot fender-benders. The remainder were roadway incidents, most of 5 which were not serious; however, two were more severe, and there was one bicycle 6 fatality on US 41 near the entrance to Lely. District 3 has the largest homeless 7 population, as it spans areas near the courthouse and locations like St. Matthews House, which offer various services. A program has been established with St. Matthews' 8 9 Homeless Outreach Team (HOT), where counselors go out with Sheriff's monthly to educate, encourage, and enforce. They also provide individuals with information on 10 11 available resources. There is a concern about e-bikes being stolen. Lt. McManus urged people to write their e-bike serial numbers down in the event it gets stolen. Mr. Campkin 12 13 asked if Sheriff's patrol inside the gated communities, Lt. McManus confirmed they do. 14 There have been three fatality crashes so far in District 3 in 2025, none have been in

15 the Lely CDD area.
